- 2015, Picpoul de Pinet Domaine de Montredon, France 22
Picpoul is the Muscadet of the south. Crisp, mineral and enticing. Our favourite with seafood.
- 2015, Las Condes Sauvignon Blanc, Central Valley, Chile 17
Vivid and aromatic Chilean Sauvignon blanc with a pretty elderflower and tropical fruit.
- 2014, Albarino Lagar de Bouza, Galicia, Spain 28
A fashionable seafood wine from Galicia's rugged coast. Great structure and definition.
- 2014, Pinot Grigio, Ca'Tesore, Italy 18
A superior Pinot Grigio from Veneto in central Italy. More interest and texture than many.
- 2014, Macon Charnay, Domaine Tripoz Bourgogne, France 27
Plenty of citrus fruit is balanced by mouth-watering acidity and lovely texture. A small Domaine.
- 2014, Viognier Mont Rocher, Languedoc, France 21
The 'appricotty' Viognier grape can show great balance and finesse in the Languedoc.
- 2014, Sauvignon de Touraine Alain Marcadet, France 23
This Touraine sauvignon is delightfully elegant with hints of elderflower and refreshing acidity.
- 2014, Chablis Domaine Savary, Bourgogne, France 30
A classic 'seashell' Chablis from a wonderful family producer. Minimal pesticides are used.
- 2015, Greywacke Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, New Zealand 32
Is this the new Cloudy Bay? The producer Kevin Judd ran Cloudy Bay for 25 years and he now makes this modern icon. Stunning!
- 2012, Rully, Domaine Chanson, Chalonais, France 35
A wonderfully balanced white Burgundy with lively fruit, poised acidity and restrained oak.
- 2012, Chassagne Montrachet, Jean Marc Pillot, Burgundy, France 65
This is classic fine white burgundy. Honey lemon colour and complex. The taste will last and last.

ROSE WINE

- 2014, Bella Modella Pinot Grigio Rosé 18
Dry, pale, elegant and attractive rosé from this ever popular grape.
- 2015, Cotes de Provence, Domaine Sainte Marie, France 29
Stunning pale rose from a Domaine right by the coast where the cooling breezes lead to a freshness and vibrancy. Grown organically.

RED WINE

- 2014, Negroamaro I Muri Vigneti di Salento, Puglia, Italy 24
A wonderfully generous warming Puglian red. A big adventure in a glass!
- 2015, Bardolino, Monte Del Fra, Veneto, Italy 21
Light and juicy! A fresh sweet cherry and summer berry taste. Easy drinking wine with a pleasant touch of aromatic spice and cranberry to finish.
- 2015, Las Condes Merlot, Central Valley, Chile 17
Smooth, supple and dark-fruited Merlot. Very easy drinking.
- 2014, Turi Carmenere, Vina Leyda, Central Valley, Chile 19
Deep aromas of blackberries, herbs, white pepper and coffee. Intense and juicy with a silky texture and subtle oaky notes.
- 2014, Centelleo Tempranillo, Castilla, Spain 18
Supple and easy drinking modern Spanish red. Warming fruits and a peppery finish.
- 2014, Kaiken Malbec Reserve, Mendoza, Argentina 22
Rich dark fruits such as blackberries with notes of coffee and chocolate from oak aging. Well balanced elegant tannins and a creamy tangerine finish.
- 2014, Cotes du Rhone M. Chapoutier, Rhone, France 24
Chapoutier is a legend of the Rhône and this packs plenty of warmth, weight and punch.
- 2013, Rioja Crianza Puerto Viejo, Bodegas Riojanas, Spain 25
Wonderful Rioja with 18 months in oak to give a creamy texture and warm spicy finish.
- 2014, Sherwood Estate Pinot Noir, Waipara, New Zealand 26
Smooth, supple and velvety Pinot Noir, but with an elegance and finesse. Beguiling indeed!
- 2011, Cantina Valpatena, Amarone della Valpolicella, Italy 55
The Amarone style involves air drying the grapes to intensify the flavour. This wine is big and powerful with sweet dark fruit characters.

Cracking Prosecco Spumante. Vibrant pear and apple fruit. Deliciously easy drinking.
